Basic Assumption

- The Project will start with 20 cows and expected that at the end of five years the number of cows will be 50.
- Each year after Eid-ul Adha cows will be purchased & sales at the time of next Eid-ul Adha.
- Other than sales of cow revenue will be generated from selling of cow dung.
- Two types of cows (Tk. 15,000+ & Tk. 20,000+) will be purchased.
- Assume that each cow consumed Tk. 3,240 food will increase by 20% each year.

Risk Factors

- Affected by metabolic disorders, respiratory, youngstock, udder & zoonoses;
- Theft;
- Unavailability of food;
- Regular Treatment.

Risk Management

- Adequate precaution to be taken, i.e. vaccination, medicine etc;
- Proper security measures will be taken;
- Adequate Food will be stored properly;
- Keep regular contact with Veterinary Surgeon.
